ENCOUNTERS WITH INFINITY



In the plant world many forces act on the shaping of their different organs and on the regulation of their growing and developing processes.

Where do these forces come from and how do they relate to the substances that constitute the plant?

This course, through a qualitative scientific approach, is designed to help in the understanding of the subtle relationships between the formative forces and the substances that constitute the plant which in their final configuration reveal the magnificent interplay of different realms of existence.

We shall use elements of Projective Geometry to bring about a change in one's thinking which is the key to a positive but real understanding of the development processes in the plant.

In this course we will concentrate, to begin with, on the fundamental polarity of Earth and Sun, for this is archetypal When the idea has been fully experienced and scientifically understood, the way will be open to perceive in detail how the true nature of the plant reveals also the true nature of the galaxy – of the great organism within which all life on Earth takes place. The plant must reveal herself in full glory – an ethereal form clothed in earthly substance, living, unfolding, metamorphosing between "Earth and Sun", amid the sun-like, through the differenciated cosmic forces of the planets and the stars.
